

## Art

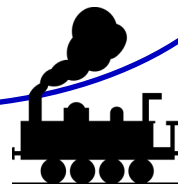
Find out about the artist **Monet**. Which picture do you like? Why? Can you create some **art** in the **style** of Monet?

## Music

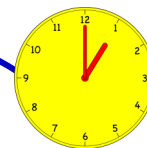
Use things from the recycling box to make your own **musical instruments**. What sort of **sounds** do they make? Listen to different types of music—talk about what you like and what you can hear.
